基本手順

1. 空所の前後 1～2 文を読む
2. 接続問題か内容復元かを判断
3. 入る内容を日本語で予測
4. 選択肢で確認

短い例文 A | 接続・論理関係

Tom practiced every day. (), he won the race.

前：毎日練習した → 後：勝った。結果を表す語句を予測する。

短い例文 B | 内容復元

The new library is popular with students. (). As a result, many students go there after school.

後ろの As a result を見て、空所には「行きたくなる理由」が必要だと予測する。

ポイント：全文和訳ではなく、空所の前後と文のつながりを見る。

実戦演習：Repair Cafés

Many people throw away small appliances or other household items when they stop working. In some cities, however, people have started holding events called repair cafés. (1) At these events, visitors bring broken lamps, radios, toys, and other items. Volunteers with repair skills examine the items and try to fix them together with the owners.

Repair cafés have several benefits. Visitors may save money because they do not need to buy new products immediately. They can also learn simple repair skills from experienced volunteers. (2), keeping useful products for a longer time can reduce the amount of waste that is sent to landfills.

These events are not always easy to organize. Some repairs require special parts or tools, and volunteers may not be able to fix every item. (3) This means organizers sometimes need to limit how many objects each visitor can bring or ask people to wait until another event.
